Group Conscience Motion

I would like to make a motion that members who choose this group as their **home group** recognize this as their **only home group**.

A member may attend and participate in any Alcoholics Anonymous meetings they choose, but for voting, service positions, and group business matters, each person may have **only one designated home group at a time**.

The purpose of this is to keep group conscience decisions clear and to encourage commitment and accountability within the group.

If our group wants to keep a simple record of who identifies the group as their **home group**, here are a few practical options that respect anonymity while documenting membership for group business.

A member during the meeting has to turn on their camera and announce that they want to become a member. Host, chair or co-host documents and sends the information to the secretary who is keeping a log.

Members who declare this as their home group will be added to the Home Group Member List maintained by the group secretary. Only members on this list may vote on group conscience matters.

Keep a list only **for members eligible to vote in group conscience/business meetings**.

Example:

Current Home Group Members Eligible to Vote

- Sarah
- Mike
- David
- Jen

Updated monthly by group secretary.

Best for: Groups focused mainly on voting clarity.
