Reports

Chair Report: Liz reports that aaHG has been going for 5.42 years, or 1978 days, or 44,472 meetings and thanks everyone for their continued support and service to this meeting. Liz also reports that there is 1 concern in process and that she is continuing to meet with the MAL to review the governance documents with a focus on the traditions and reports that these documents will be reviewed at the next steering committee meeting. Liz also reported on an Ad Hoc committee that came about from Andi's motion to increase GC attendance and the members who were asked to be on the committee.

Secretary Report: Andi reports that we have received no new motions, and asks that everyone send motions to secretary@aahomegroup.org, and asks that everyone send sobriety

birthdays to soberbirthdays@aahomegroup.org. Andi also reports that June GC will be out asap now that Jo has her new computer. Andi notes that we are up to date with all other GC and SC meeting minutes.

Scheduling Report: Ash reports that the hours of Midnight at 1:30 EST continue to be the hardest to fill, and that we need hosts more than anything else. Ash also reports that the committee continues to meet weekly, noting that every meeting needs one Host, one Chair, and one Safety. Ash also reports that TS can now serve up to 4 hours daily, then must take a 2 hour break before continuing service.

Training Report: Brent reports receiving 28 new TS Volunteer forms and have trained 8 new TS between August 1st and August 13th. Brent also notes that all trainees who choose to proceed in training are paired with a trainer to continue their progress.

OIAA Report: Renee reports that the recent OIAA meetings have been focuses on hybrid meetings and virtual reality meetings, and that OIAA is holding a convention November 14th-16th.

IT Report: Duane reports that the website has been updated regularly, and that he would like to start the process of switching the database for our schedule from Google and will meet with Ash to discuss.

Treasurer Report: Albert reports the group's treasurer report (see below) and \$163 in contributions for July, and that Rachael will send IT payments for zoom bills.

The group had a discussion about Venmo and how to get more 7th tradition contributions.

Safety Report: Ato notes that safety is a shared responsibility, not just the job of the safety and security team and thanks everyone who helps to keep the meeting safe. Ato also reports that we currently have 45 people on the disruptor list and asks members to continue to add all disruptors to the list to be reviewed, and to tag Marissa and Ato in the chats when disruptions occur.

Communication and Literature Report: Harold reports that issues of 7 and 8 of The Trudge have been restored, and that he is working to recreate issue 9. Harold also reports that all links, chat posts, and lists are up to date, and the Communication email is up to date.
